

Four-Room Maze User Guide

Installation

The program will run with QB64 GL1.2 and higher. Use the URL to download the zip file and extract the folder “Pelmanism” into your QB64 folder. (When extracting the folder, be careful that the extraction method doesn't create a further level of folder with the same name). From the IDE, load the program “Pelman_v2.bas” and make sure that you have the Run Option “Save EXE in source folder” checked.

For the largest-sized puzzle, your screen width needs to be larger than 1300. If your monitor resolution is smaller than this, you will need to use the techniques of \$RESIZE in the code.

When you first run the program, you will be asked to Mouse Click with your normal mouse button – this tells the program which is your correct button.

Playing the Game

The game is a simple Pairs Matching game. You have to remember where the matching pairs are, and the few number of attempts you make to match all pairs the better. There are three levels of difficulty: 12, 18 and 30 pairs.

Choose the level of difficulty by either selecting 1, 2 or 3 by mouse click or by typing 1, 2 or 3.



Selections are made by single mouse click. When a square is clicked, it turns over to reveal the image. A second square reveals another picture. If the two are the same they will remain displayed, but if they are different they will turn back over. You can click on the 'Quit' sign to finish your game (or type 'Q'). You will be asked if you wish to play a new game. Pressing Esc at any time will quit the program.
